Kennedy Jr exposes \$32 mn active US biolabs in Ukraine

The US has long dismissed claims about the biological research laboratories in Ukraine as "Russian propaganda" until senior State Department official Victoria Nuland confirmed their existence at a 2022 Senate hearing. The Pentagon continues to insist the research is neither illegal nor intended for military purposes. The Russian military has discovered evidence that the US was creating "biological weapons components" at facilities in Ukraine, Lieutenant General Igor Kirillov testified to lawmakers in Moscow earlier this year. Ukraine "is a proxy in, essentially, a struggle between two superpowers, between Russia and the US and the US military outsourced some of its biological weapons research to the government installed by the 2014 coup in Kyiv". Democrat presidential hopeful Robert F. Kennedy Junior has claimed in an recent interview to Twitter. "We have biolabs in Ukraine because we're developing bioweapons," RFK Jr told independent journalist Tucker Carlson

in a lengthy conversation recently posted on X (formerly Twitter). Though the US signed the ban on bioweapons in the 1970s, he explained, the Patriot Act adopted after the 9/11 terrorist attacks in 2001 allowed the Pentagon to resume research. RFK Jr is the nephew of the 35th president, John F. Kennedy, and the son of Robert Kennedy, JFK's attorney general who went on to become a senator. Both brothers would end up being assassinated - JFK in 1963, and RFK in 1968 during the presidential primaries. RFK Jr. is challenging fellow Democrat and incumbent president Joe Biden for the party's presidential nomination. This is for the first time a American politician has come out in the open on this alarming issue. The UN's High Representative for Disarmament Affairs, Izumu Nakamitsu, had in October 2022 had informed ambassadors that the UN had seen no evidence of biological weapons use in Ukraine! Rightly, Russia too had lodged a formal complaint to the Security

Council under Article VI of the Convention, stating that Ukraine and the US had not provided "necessary explanations". Ambassador Vassily Nebenzya of Russia said issues still outstanding from the consultative meeting must be resolved, and argued that its complaint was well founded. He cited a 2005 Agreement between the Pentagon and Ukraine's Ministry of Health regarding cooperation on preventing dissemination of technologies, pathogens and information that can be used to develop biological weapons. "The direct participation of the Pentagon in financing the military biological activity in Ukraine is reflected in the plan on providing technical assistance to certain recipients of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, dated 2018. This is under the same 2005 agreement," he said. "The real beneficiary of funds is the Ukraine

Ministry of Defense laboratories in Kyiv, Lviv, Odesa, and Kharkiv." The world knows that the Pentagon -through various channels- pumped \$32 million into laboratories located in Kiev, Odessa, Lvov and Kharkov. These biolabs were chosen to oversee a "project aimed at studying the pathogens of the Congo-Crimean hemorrhagic fever, leptospirosis and hantaviruses." The Russians believe that interest in these pathogens is due to the fact "their use can be disguised as natural outbreaks of diseases", which is why the project received additional funding. In other words, the Russians think that the US funding was mainly aimed at biological weapons development. The Chinese appear to agree with Russia on this matter. According to Kennedy, the bio weapons programme has operated under the guise of

"life sciences" research, such as gain-of-function experiments on viruses and other pathogens, ultimately overseen by Dr. Anthony Fauci, who headed the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases between 1984 and 2022. Modern bioweapons are "frightening stuff," made with genetic engineering tools such as CRISPR, Kennedy said. When some of these "bugs" escaped from laboratories in the US, back in 2014, the Obama administration banned gain-of-function research, Kennedy added, so Fauci outsourced it overseas. "A lot of them went to Ukraine," Kennedy told Carlson, while some of the research was moved to the Wuhan, China laboratory, the suspected origination point for the Covid-19 pandemic. Most of the research was funded by the Pentagon, or by USAID, which Kennedy described as "a CIA cutout." After the Corona threat and the following total lock down that dominated 2021, well since 2022 it is surely the Ukraine crisis that spell doom to global peace and

economy. Another alarming aspect that was in the undercurrent as USA, EU and NATO starting pouring financial assistance and deadly weapons, "What happens if Ukraine turns bad and goes rogue?" The valid poser raised by experts in armed conflict was what happens to weapons sent by US, NATO fall into dark net and eventually to terrorists...? It is pertinent to recall why US invaded Iraq. Along with Iraq's alleged development of weapons of mass destructions, another justification for invasion was the purported link between Saddam Hussein's Government and terrorist organisations, in particular

al-Qaeda. In that sense, the Bush administration cast the Iraq war as part of the broader war on terrorism. Before that the United States sold Iraq over \$ 200 million in helicopters, which were used by the Iraqi military in the war. These were the only direct U.S.-Iraqi military sales. At the same time, the U.S. provided substantial covert support

for Saddam Hussein. Since the 2003 invasion of Iraq, several reported finds of chemical weapons were announced, including half a dozen incidents during the invasion itself. And yet Iraq did not use these weapons against the US-led coalition forces, even as they soundly defeated the Iraqi army, pushing it from Kuwait, now one wonders why?

POV Homeless and Suicide crises in the USA

Twenty years ago, I visited the USA. I used to spend a lot of time in New York. One thing that was disturbing me was the number of homeless people begging on the pavement right in front of a branded shop. I used to visit America every year and see the same dismal sight of homeless and poor people in most of the cities. Early this month, I visited Hollywood and was perturbed to see the number of Homeless people settled in Venice Beach. It appears that the Homeless population is escalating from New York to Los Angeles. It is a mind boggling crisis that remains unsolved in the richest country in the world.

In June 2023, the Homeless population on any given night in Los Angeles was estimated at 46,260 people. In May 2023, there were 83,649 homeless people sleeping each night in the New York City municipal shelter system. On a national level the Department of Housing and Urban Development counted that around 582,000 Americans experiencing homelessness in 2022. According to the Department of Housing and Urban Development, it would cost \$ 20 billion to end homelessness in the United States. It is a big number, but it is not difficult to find the funds to end poverty in the US.

The US government which is concerned about Syria and Ukraine and is extending billions in humanitarian assistance, is not prone to solving this domestic problem of homelessness.

The US provided more than \$ 16.6 billion to Syria and Ukraine. Between January 24, 2022 and May 31, 2023, the US provided around 70.7 billion Euros to the war effort in Ukraine. The US administration can easily fund the \$ 20 billion and end homelessness, and claiming it is the only country without people begging for survival.

Suicide
Suicide reached a record high in 2022, with nearly 50,000 people ending their lives, according to provisional data released by the US Centers for Disease Prevention. The report was released on Thursday. "The suicide rate among males in 2021 was four times higher than among females" the CDC reported. Males make up 50 percent of the population but nearly 80 percent of suicides are male. The reason for suicide is that "people are finding themselves empty and thirsty, with nowhere to go to satisfy their deep thirsts". Mental health is also attributed to the cause of suicide. There are also other problems that contribute, such as those related to relationships, substance use, physical health, job security, money, and housing stress.
